

# **DRYA JUNIOR SAILING**

## **2007 Scoring**

### **DRYA Regattas**

420s, FJs, FJ Collegiates, Laser, and Laser Radials: Low Point System as described in RRS Appendix A will be used.

Optimists: USODA scoring system will be used. Red, White and Blue fleet assignments are based on age on Day 1 of Regatta 1 and remain in place for the season unless modified by the DRYA. Green fleet assignments are until the skipper has placed in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in three regattas.

### **Season Champions**

To qualify for a season championship, a competitor must participate in 75% of all DRYA sanctioned and sailed races including River Championships.

### **Boy Skipper of the Year**

A competitor must participate in 75% of all DRYA sanctioned and sailed races including River Championships. Additionally, mandatory participation and inclusion of points from the DRYA SBS eliminations is required.

### **Girl Skipper of the Year**

A competitor must participate in 75% of all DRYA sanctioned and sailed races including River Championships. Additionally, mandatory participation and inclusion of points from the DRYA SBS eliminations or DRYA Leiter Cup is required.

### **Crew of the Year**

One award for either a boy or girl is to be made using the same criteria as in Skipper of the Year.

### **Sportsmanship and Shipshape**

The instructors may select winners for each boat type and/or age group. The instructors may also select a winner for the overall perpetual Sportsmanship Trophy,

### **River Championships**

A separate regatta is held for 420s, FJs, FJ Collegiates, Lasers, Laser Radials, and Optimists (one class). No minimum number of races is required.
