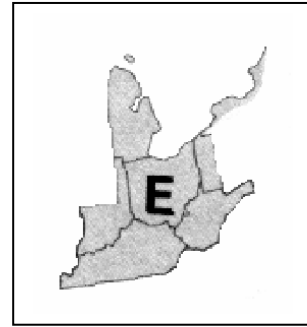


Notice of Race
O'Day Area E Singlehanded Championship
Held in Conjunction with the
Lansing Sailing Club's Annual Laser Regatta,
June 11, 2005



Rules: These races shall be conducted under the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008 as modified by the Prescriptions of US SAILING, the current Championship Conditions, The International Laser Class Rules (ILCA), the Notice of Race (NOR) including any amendments to the NOR except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions, and the Sailing Instructions.

Alteration of Class Rules: ILCA rules are altered so that membership in the Class is not required; the first sentence of ILCA rule 9 is deleted; and a compass may be taped to the deck.

Advertising: The event is classified as a Category A event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code).

Boats: The event will be sailed in Laser Class boats (bring your own).

Eligibility: All competitors MUST BE:

- A. At least age 16 years in the Calendar year.
- B. Must be members of US Sailing.
- C. A member of the following:
 - 1) A Sailing Club or Sailing Organization (SC/SO) or Laser Class Association, belonging to a Sailing Organization (SA) recognized by US SAILING;
 - 2) A Sailing Club or Sailing Organization, or Laser Class Association, belonging directly to US SAILING;
 - 3) A Community Sailing Program (CSP) which is a member of the local SA;
 4. A member of or a drilling Reservist of the Military Service.
- D. Each Competitor's SA/SO, CSP shall be located within the geographical borders of Area E.
- E. No competitor after entering this elimination may enter any other elimination for the finals for this year, after participating in this elimination.

Entry Fee: The entry fee shall be U.S. \$25.00 due at check in. Includes trophies, rolls & juice at registration, powerbars-fruit-water lunch, and steak or chicken dinner.

Registration: Pre-registration by June 4, 2005 is encouraged. Registration must be on the Official entry application forms. The Entry Forms are the same ones as are used for the Finals and can be downloaded the US SAILING website under: Racing, US Championships, Cups, O'Day, and then Download Regatta Info. You will get the entire NOR for the Finals, but only the first page of the Entry form is needed for the Eliminations. The completed form can be Emailed or mailed to:

the Jury: Decisions of the Jury will be not be subject to appeal as this is elimination event.

Life Jackets All competitors in US SAILING Championships, at all levels, shall wear, while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing a U.S. Coast Guard (or Canadian) approved PFD, except when ORC regulations apply.

Note: It is expected that the highest placed eligible finisher will compete in the O'Day National Championship to be held at the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, August 17-21, 2005.
