At the seminar you will need your own copy of The Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS"), and you will be able to purchase a copy of the Join the Race Committee Team. People who register will be sent a set of race management Study Questions to be used in preparation of the seminar.

The Club Race Officer certification test, which is given at the conclusion of the seminar, is optional. However, in order to be certified in US SAILING'S new race officer program, you are required to attend a complete basic seminar and to pass the test. In order to be certified as a Club Race Officer you will also need to have your own copy of the current (1997) US SAILING Race Management Handbook, (a new edition is in process) and meet the program's other criteria.
