ALL COURSES SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association’s “2009 DRYA Sailing Instructions” for “A/B” and “C” Courses are hereby adopted for this Regatta with the following modifications relating to the paragraphs below:

PARAGRAPH 6 CLASS FLAGS is modified by the “A/B” COURSE ORDER OF STARTS.

PARAGRAPH 16 - PROTESTS is modified to read as follows: Submit written protests at the DYC Reception Counter by 1700 hours or 45 minutes after finishing, whichever is later. (Suggestion: Request that the time of receipt be noted on the protest form.)

Parties to a protest will be notified of the time and place for the protest hearing. Notice to boats that are parties to a protest committee hearing will be given by posting the names and sail numbers of such boats on the bulletin board at the Detroit Yacht Club with the results of the regatta by 1705 hours on the day of the regatta, or as soon thereafter the awards are presented. The Race Committee also will attempt to notify such boats by telephone or other means.

RADIO MONITORING - Boats are requested to monitor channel 72 for the “A/B” starts, channel 71 for the “C” starts, from 1 hour before the warning of the first class until after finishing.

***REGISTRATION JIB AND MAIN**

Boats racing in this class must either be on the DRYA Valid List or submit an application for a 2010 DRYA Intra Club Jib & Main Rating to DRYA no later than 1600 hours Wednesday, September 8, 2010. The JAM Rating Application and submission instructions are available on the sailing Information link at www.dyc.com or the 2007 DRYA Jib & Main link at www.drya.org.

A rating must be issued by DRYA in order for a boat to be scored.

Boats in JAM are not required to fly a pennant from their backstay, except that DYC boats are requested to fly the DYC burgee on the backstay approximately six feet off the deck. Boats in DYC Jam will participate only in Race One.

Awards will be presented to the top three boats from the DYC JAM fleet and also to the top three JAM boats not from DYC.
