DBC Learn to Sail Program

KEY Benefits of the DBC program are:

Class Description

Novice Sailing Program

DBC is proud to offer this entry-level class for students who have little or no sailing experience. It is held jointly with the Edison Boat Club, at their clubhouse on the Detroit River at 100 Lycaste, Detroit. The course is designed to be an entertaining and simple introduction to sailing and water safety. Each sailor will learn the basics of sailing: parts of the boat, rigging (set up) sails, steering the boat, leaving & returning to the dock under sail, and water safety. Students are also introduced to basics of racing with their fellow students, and will have opportunities for longer races on Lake St. Clair as the class progresses.

This is a hands-on, get-wet (from bow spray, not capsizes) and have-a-lot of fun type of class. This course is designed to build skills and confidence through time on the water, chats on shore, and focus on fundamentals of sailing, safety and boat handling. Full Tuition for the Beginner Class is \$355. Fee less for additional family members.

Course is based on US Sailing material and hands on sailing. No previous boating experience is required.

Requirements

Sailors need to be at least 14 years old. They must weigh at least 80 lbs and feel comfortable around the water. Sailors need to be on time. All participants must wear a proper fitting life jacket at all times on the docks and boats! If you do not own a life jacket, one can be provided for you! Shoes are required to be worn at all times on the docks! A spare set of clothes recommended. *As guests of EBC All participants must behave in a respectful manner on the grounds and in the water. This is an instructional program, to teach the fundamentals of sailing. We reserve the right to dismiss any student, if they cannot respect the basic rules of the club and/or the program. Please note: There is a 10 mph speed limit on the property that must be obeyed.*

Recommended:

Bring and wear sun block, sunglasses & hat with retaining straps and towel.
