The DRYA is offering a PHRFASM Class starting 2016. The Class will be following Rules established for the BYC's Mackinac Race and as outlined in Section 15 are shown below.

If you are interested in joining this class, please contact the DRYA Chief Handicapper or sign up under PHRFASM on the DRYA annual renewal form. Other items of interest are as follows:

The start has it's own start on 'A' Course. This start is the second start of the day. The race pennant for the class will be Class Flag E.

PHRFASM Class Rules

This Class will be open to all boats that possess a valid PHRF certificate.

Participants in the Class have elected Com. Robert Schappe (spectref3@hotmail.com) who will be the spokesman for the Class in future matters.

The Class Rules will be patterned on the BYC Cruising Class for the BYC Mackinac Race and are outlined DRYA Handbook Section 15.

Boats will be subject to the following limitations:

- Asymmetrical spinnakers including Code Zeros are limited to a max of 2 on board.
- Symmetrical spinnakers may not be used.
- Asymmetrical spinnakers may be flown provided they (a) are flown without a whisker or spinnaker pole and (b) are attached to a tack point (or are attached to a tack line that is led to a tack point) that is no more than 12 inches forward of the jib tack point on the centerline of the hull.
- Whisker or spinnaker poles may be used only for poling out headsails.
