## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association's 2005 Sailing Instructions for "A", "B" and "C" Courses are hereby adopted for this Regatta, with the following modifications:

**Paragraph 2. Entries** Add: Sail yachts owned by members of the Grosse Pointe Sail Club are invited to register with GPSC and compete in the GPSC Club JAM Class. This class will do the Long "C" Course and will do one race only. Registration forms may be obtained from Frank Ferry (800/764-2593) or from the GPSC website (<http://gpsc.org/>). Registrations for this class must be received no later than June 27, 2005. Sailing Instructions will be mailed to all registered Club Class racers.

**Paragraph 16. Protests** Revised: A protesting yacht shall lodge a written protest with the GPSC Protest Chair, or his delegate, within two hours after finishing on the day of the Regatta. Protests are to be filed in the Windmill Pointe Park outer entrance guard station, Grosse Pointe Park. Protests will be heard at Bayview Yacht Club on Monday, July 11, 2005 at 1930.

## AFTER THE REGATTA

The Grosse Pointe Sail Club cordially invites the skippers and crews of competing yachts, and their guests, to attend the Regatta Awards Party beginning at 1600 until approximately 1800 at the Tompkins Center, Windmill Pointe Park. There will be beverages provided and a buffet available (cost is \$7.00 for adults, \$4.00 for children).

## AWARDS

Race results will be posted at the Tompkins Center as soon as possible following the race; class awards will be presented at the Tompkins Center at approximately 1800. Awards will be as follows: One boat: 1<sup>st</sup> place flag; Two boats: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place flags; Three or more boats: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place flags.
