**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association's "2005" Sailing Instructions for "A", "B", and "C" Courses" are hereby adopted for this Regatta with the following modifications relating to the paragraph below:

**PARAGRAPH 6 - CLASS FLAGS**

is modified by changing CLASS B-1 to DYC JAM, Doublehanded, and All Others. The other B CLASSES starting with C&C 35, now start B-2, are also renumbered in sequence.

**PARAGRAPH C-3**

is modified to read: Boats in the Flying Scot class will sail the Long "C" Course (Start 1, 2, 1, Finish)

**PARAGRAPH 17 - PROTESTS**

is modified to read as follows: Submit written protests at the DYC Reception Counter by 1900 hours. (Suggestion: Request that time of receipt be noted on the protest form.)

Protests will be heard at the Bayview Yacht Club on Monday, September 12, 2005, at 1930 hours.

Notice to boats, that are parties to a protest committee hearing, will be given by posting the names and sail numbers of such boats on the bulletin board at the Detroit Yacht Club, with the results of the regatta, by 2000 hours on the day of the regatta. The Race Committee also will attempt to notify such boats by telephone or other means.
