The Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association’s 2008 Sailing Instructions for “A/B” and “C” Courses are hereby adopted for this Regatta, with the following modifications:

Paragraph 1, Rules - Class rules, where applicable will be those adopted by local fleets for DRYA participation.

Paragraph 16, Protest is modified to read as follows:

“Submit written protest to the GPYC Switchboard (Front Desk) within two hours of your finish. Protests will be heard at the Bayview Yacht Club at 19:30 hours, Monday, August 11.
