

Notes concerning throwouts:

As in the past a "**DSQ**" **must be counted** and will not be thrown out.

The scheduled regattas are shown on reverse. In the event one or more regattas are eliminated or added, the following schedule will be used. Individual classes may elect a different schedule of counters and throw outs of the scheduled regattas.

Throwouts are allowed according to the following table with the exception that DSQs cannot be throwout.

The above chart is applicable for all DRYA Regatta Series unless modified by the DRYA Executive Committee and ratified by the DRYA member clubs Race Chairmen at the annual spring Race Chairmen's Meeting.

The preceding supercedes paragraphs 13.4 and 13.7 of the DRYA Handbook (revised 4/17/96).

Paragraph 12.2 (Regatta Scoring) of the DRYA Handbook (revised 4/17/96) is revised, regarding ties, to conform to be as follows:

Regatta Scoring will be Low Point Scoring (Appendix A9). See separate sheet for scoring examples.

Total points for the regatta determines place.

In the event of a tie:

- the first tie breaker is: most 1st, most 2nd, most 3rd, etc.
- the next tie breaker is total corrected time for the regatta races
- the next tie breaker is best position in the last race

Series Scoring will be High-Point Percentage Scoring. See separate sheet for scoring examples. DSQ's must be counted.

Note: High-Point Percentage is the same method DRYA has used for over 20 years for season scoring.
