MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES (DRYA ByLaws 1.1 c)

- **Sustaining Member:** A person who is a member in good standing of a DRYA Member Club or an Affiliated Sailing Organization shall be eligible to become a Sustaining Member of the Association.
- **Family Member:** A person who is the child under the age of 21 or the spouse of a Sustaining DRYA Member shall be eligible to become a Family Member of the Association.
- **Junior Member:** A person under the age of 21 who is a junior member in good standing of a DRYA Member Club, a member in good standing of the Association's Junior Sailing organization or the child of a member in good standing of a DRYA Member Club shall be eligible to become a Junior Member of the Association.
- **Collegiate Member:** A person who is an undergraduate member in good standing of a collegiate sailing club that is a member of the Midwest Collegiate Sailing Association (MCSA) shall be eligible to become a Collegiate Member of the Association.
- **Associate Member:** A person who is not otherwise eligible (e.g. not a member of a current DRYA club) to become a member of the Association with an interest in sail racing and the activities of the Association and it's Member Clubs shall be eligible to become an Associate Member of the Association. (e.g.: crew on boats, not a member of a current DRYA Club))
- **Provisional Members:** A person who is not a member of a DRYA Member Club or an Affiliated Sailing Organization, who has never been a member of the Association but who owns and wishes to race a yacht in regattas sponsored by Member Clubs, shall be eligible to become a Provisional Member of the Association, provided that a person may not be a Provisional Member more than 12 consecutive months. (e.g.: new to area not yet affiliated w/ a Club and wants to race in DRYA Counter Series races)
- **Contributing Member:** A person who is eligible to become a member of the Association and who pays specified dues in an amount greater than those established by the Executive Committee for any other category of individual membership shall be eligible to become a Contributing Member of the Association.

Boats in Classes & Ratings Used for Scoring

PHRF 1 – 4 Rating: Race, PHRF CRUISE, or JAM Ratings)

- All boats flying Sym. or Asym. Chutes with spinnaker poles.
- All sprit boats that are not in a DRYA Class e.g. J120's.
- All One Design boats that do not comply with their OD Rules e.g. use an RFG where the Class does not allow it or have larger sails.
- All One Design boats that are not in a DRYA Class e.g. Tartan 10's.
- All Cutter, Ketch, Yawl or Schooner rigged boats.
- All boats that do not meet the PHRF Cruise Class Rules e.g. Have a larger sail inventory than allowed by the rules.
 - Note: Boats that fully meet the PHRF CRUISE Class Rules can sail in PHRF 1-4 classes with their PHRF CRUISE Rating

These boats will be scored to their season assigned class of PHRF, PHRF CRUISE or JAM ratings. If on day of race they declare to RC a short-handed crew exception and move to CLUB JAM start, they will be scored with their JAM rating.

PHRF-CRUISE Rating: PHRF CRUISE only

- Boats using asymmetrical spinnaker (a) are flown without a whisker or spinnaker pole and (b) attached to a tack point (or attached to a tack line that is led to a tack point) that is no more than 12 inches forward of the jib tack point on the centerline of the hull.
- AND meet all other PHRF CRUISE requirements in Section 15.10 (Nov 2019)

PHRF-DELTA Rating: Special Rating per PHRF DELTA Class Rule

- PHRF 1-4, PHRF CRUISE or JAM boats with scoring with a DRYA DELTA "Golf Handicap System" controlled by the DRYA Chief Scorer.
