

SSI 12. THE START is modified to provide that the Warning Signal will be at 1855 hour. There will only be one race. The starting area will be located off CSYC outer wall.

STARTING LINE: The starting line shall be between an orange inflated pyramid buoy or markset bot and a RC Flag on the Race Committee Station located on the CSYC outer seawall. A limit mark (red/green horizontal bands) may be set near the inboard end (seawall end) of the starting line.

SSI 14. THE FINISH is added to state that the finishing area will be located off the CSYC Outer Wall. The finish line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the seawall and the port end orange tetrahedron with a flashing white light. When finishing, all racers shall display a MAC-style luminous number sign on the starboard side of the boat or illuminate their sail numbers.

SSI 15. SHORTENING COURSE is revised to read if the mark-set boat displays Flag S at a mark then the course will be to round the mark in the course direction and then to the finish line.

SSI 16. TIME LIMITS is modified to read: The time limit for each class is 4 hours after the starting signal for that class.

**SSI 17. HEARING REQUESTS-
PROTESTS**

is modified to delete the clause “is 1900hrs on the day of the Regatta ”.

NOTE. Sailors are advised that they must carry individual identification documents such as Drivers Licenses or valid Passports when crossing the border either on land or water between the US and Canada.

The 2026 DRYA NOR and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI) shall apply for this Regatta unless modified below. All Course Specific W/L Instructions are deleted. Where differences between these documents occur the EBC SSI shall govern.

NOR 3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY EBC REGATTA

3.8 EBC YACHTS

All EBC JAM yachts racing in the JAM start will also be scored separately for EBC Club only Awards. They must fly the EBC burgee on the backstay.

3.9 ENTRIES FROM DRYA MEMBER CLUBS AND OTHER CLUBS OR INDIVIDUALS

Please see the DRYA NOR and DRYA Sailing Instructions. Yachts entering this Regatta must have a current MWPHRF or ORC rating.

INVITED BOATS Invited boats are permitted to enter any class offered . Invited boats shall also register on the DRYA website by Tuesday mid-day prior to the regatta and pay any appropriate fees. EBC JAM boats are free..

Links available at drya.org home page in “Upcoming Events”. EBC and the RC will not accept any requests for additions to the Scratch Sheets after the deadline.

Boats that are short of crew on race day may call the PRO on the VHF channel 72 prior to the warning signal for the JAM or OFF start and declare they will race in the JAM or OFF start for the Regatta . Boats calling after the warning signal will not be moved into JAM or OFF.

Boats not registered will not be scored.

NOR 6. SCHEDULE

6.1 is modified to show the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be at 1855hrs.

**SI #7.5 is modified to read as follows;
Start 9, OFF and Crescents, Class Flag F, Club Burgee Classes 2,**

SSI 9. COURSES is modified to read: All headings are magnetic and distances in NM's are approximate.
Course approximate Lat/Longs are as follows:
Starting Line – N42*24.05', W 082*52.97'
Mark 1 – N42* 27.50' W82* 51.03'
G19 – N 42* 26.41, W 082*47.43'
Finish Line – N42* 24.05, W 082*52.97

The Course

The course shall be from the Starting Line to Mark 1 3.7NM @ 30° rounding it to starboard then 2.9NM @ 120* to Mark G19 rounding it to starboard. Thence 4.7NM @248* to the finish line at CSYC Course length is approximately 11.3NM. (The Water Intake structure off CSYC must be avoided.)

10.3 Mark 1 is an orange inflatable tetrahedron
